2020-2021 School Budget

The Argyle Central School District is proposing a budget of \$13,305,750 and a tax levy increase of 1.97%, for a total tax levy of \$4,860,000 for the 2020-21 school year.

Although the NYS Tax Cap formula allows the district to increase our 2020-21 tax levy by 3.37%, the district is opting for a tax levy increase of 1.97%. The Argyle community has always supported our school and our Board of Education recognizes the difficult situation this pandemic has created for many families in our community.

Should NYS not reduce state aid projections, the 2020-21 budget as presented maintains our current academic, sports, and extracurricular programs and reflects the district's efforts to put forward a quality educational program with a tax levy increase consistent with our previous budgets.

Here are some facts about this budget:

- The proposed budget is \$58,736 less than the 2019-20 budget.
- The proposed tax levy increase of 1.97%, or \$94,000 is significantly less than the 2020-21 allowable property tax cap limit of 3.37%, or \$160,679.
- The 2020-21 budget dedicates \$350,000 of fund balance toward the cost of the 2019 capital project.

The Argyle CSD 2020-21 Budget Vote and Board of Education Elections will be held June 9th with all voting being done via absentee ballot and will occur only by mail. Absentee ballots will be forwarded to all qualified voters of the district who are currently on the Washington County Board of Elections registration of voters. Absentee ballots must be received by the district by mail by June 9, 2020 before 5:00 pm.

Anyone who meets the definition of a "qualified voter," but does not believe he/she will be on the Washington County Board of Election registration of voters, must contact the District Clerk as soon as possible to ensure timely receipt of an absentee ballot for the 2020 annual meeting/election.

The chart below shows Argyle CSD's historical budget information. In addition to the proposed 2020-21 budget information, the chart also includes the school budget, state and federal aid, and lax levy percentage increases for the last 5 years.




